The North Frog Hollow Neighborhood Revitalization Zone Committee held an adjourned regular meeting on Thursday, September 25, 2008, at 5:00 PM at the home of the chair, 16 Columbia Street. The chair, David Corrigan, was present.

Mr. Corrigan called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM, and he certified that ballots were received from the following members: Joe Barber; David Carrier; David Corrigan; Barry Lubin; Jacqueline Maldonado; Bob Painter; Broad-Park Development Corporation, as represented by Raquel Rivera; Doug Campbell; Hartford Preservation Alliance, as represented by Tom Nenortas; Immaculate Conception Shelter and Housing Corporation, as represented by Patti White; and the City of Hartford, as represented by Patrick Campbell. Mr. Corrigan further certified that the number of ballots received was sufficient under the rules of the Committee for the vote to be valid.

On the first item on the ballot, that the Committee approves the minutes for the August 2008 public hearing, the Committee voted to approve unanimously. The item was approved.

On the second item on the ballot, that the Committee approves re-authorizing Robert Painter to put together a marketing component for the home development team proposed under the homeownership initiative, the Committee voted to approve unanimously. The item was approved.


On the third item on the ballot, that the Committee approves sending a letter to the City of Hartford requesting that it take action to mow the weeds in the Bankside Grove section of Pope Park along Park Terrace, the Committee voted to approve unanimously. The item was approved.

On the fourth item on the ballot, that the Committee authorizes the chair of the Committee to draft and to transmit a letter requesting that the City take action to mow the weeds in the Bankside Grove section of Pope Park along Park Terrace, the Committee voted to approve with ten votes to approve and one to abstain. The abstention was cast by Ms. Rivera. The item was approved.

On the fifth item on the ballot, that the Committee authorizes the Public Safety subcommittee to draft and to transmit a letter requesting that the City take action to mow the weeds in the Bankside Grove section of Pope Park along Park Terrace, the Committee voted to approve with ten votes to approve and one to abstain. The abstention was cast by Ms. Rivera. The item was approved.

There being no further business before the Committee, the chair adjourned the meeting at 5:10 PM.
